Upon receipt of the deposit, a puppy from the current litter will be held in your name.

I reserve the right to not place a puppy in a home I don't feel it's suitable for.

(I will not place high herding drive dog in a non-working family home or a home with very small children)

The balance of \$400.00 will be due when the puppy is ready for his/her new home, usually at 8wks of age.

If you are having your pup shipped to you, it will be an additional \$300-\$350 for shipping, the kennel and appropriate health certificates required by the airlines. Puppies will fly via Continental PetSafe for flying in USA and Canada. I can also use Delta Dash.
Price quoted is for flying within the USA and Canada only. Contact me first if you need shipping to any other destination.

Puppies left past 9 weeks will be charged \$50 per week. This is for boarding and training fees. If the puppy is still in our possession after 12 weeks the buyer agrees to forfeit ownership of this puppy, unless otherwise discussed ahead of time.

Extremely HIGH (10+) 100% working dog! Very Driven. May have a hard time settling down without something to do. These dogs need a daily job and consistency. (ONLY for experienced BC handlers!)

High (8-10) High energy, good at trials and or working. Does well in Agility, Rally, and Frisbee etc. Will need "something" to do but will not be off the wall 24/7. Will have a good "off switch" with daily activity.

Medium (5) Capable of doing any activities, but may not be at competition levels. Will have a good "off switch".

Low (3) -Please keep in mind, a low drive Border Collie is still has a higher activity level then most breeds. These dogs will still be active but will do well in a family home and or homes with small children.

Little Foxx Farms Border Collie Guarantee

Little Foxx Farms will guarantee this puppy to be healthy and free of disease for two weeks following purchase. Your puppy will have been examined by our vet <5 days before you receive him/her. It was given a clean bill of health (puppies are not sent home without our vet's approval) You will be given a copy of the health certificate and a shot record indicating when the next shots are due.

Please avoid taking your puppy to places with a lot of other dog exposure until after the full set of shots have been received. Dog parks, Pet stores and Vet clinics are a major risk for disease exposure, especially when the pup's immune system is stressed because of the change in homes.

Your puppy will have had routine worming's and vaccines. We use Panacur (round worms, hook worms, tape worms, whip worms) and Pfizer's Vanguard plus 5 Vaccination at 6 wks., 9wks, 12wks. Rabies vaccines are given if the pup is of appropriate age. Vanguard Plus 5 covers Distemper, Adenovirus-2, Parainfluenza and Parvovirus.

Please contact me right away if your pup is showing any signs of illness after you get him/her.

Little Foxx Farms shall not be held responsible for any expenses incurred after the puppy physically changes ownership

EYES: Your puppy will be genetically free of CEA/CL because all of our dogs have been tested by Optigen labs or clear by parentage.

HIPS: All of our dogs have/will have been OFA, Prelim or PennHip tested. Any sire that was not owned by Little Foxx Farms, but used in a breeding will have also had OFA, Prelim or PennHip testing.

Even with testing hip dysplasia can occur. There are many genes that control the disease and it's not fully preventable or predictable. I do everything possible to prevent it. There are also things you, as the puppy owner, can do to prevent your pup from being at risk of HD. If you would like more information please let me know.

I will guarantee this dog to be free of hip dysplasia until the age of 5 years. The dog's hips must be PENNHIP checked between 6-36 months of age. The buyer shall be responsible for any expenses incurred for this test. A copy of the test result is to be mailed to Little Foxx Farms. If the results show the dog to have HD a replacement puppy will be given. If no puppies are available within the next 12 months a full refund will be given. The dog can be returned to Little Foxx Farms OR KEPT (preferred!) and taken care of by the owner. If the dog is to be returned to Little Foxx Farms, the cost of return shipping will be divided equally. The buyer will be responsible for the cost of shipping the replacement puppy.

HERDING: If the puppy was purchased with the intention of working livestock and it does not show any interest in livestock by the age of 15 months, the buyer may return the dog to Little Foxx Farms. (Buyer pays shipping) If Little Foxx Farms proves that the dog does work livestock within two weeks upon arrival, then NO refund/replacement shall be given. A video shall be provided as proof that the dog does work livestock within two weeks of return.

Many factors can suppress working instinct. Some of those include: Working other dogs, herding a ball or other toy, chasing cars, etc. After viewing the video the buyer may opt to take the dog back. In this case, the owner must pay \$75 per week for boarding and training the dog. (This fee is from the day the dog arrived at Little Foxx Farms.) Return shipping and boarding must be paid in advance by the buyer before the dog will be returned. This offer is only good for one month after the date the dog was returned to Little Foxx Farms. If the dog is not picked up or shipping/boarding is not paid after one month, you agree to forfeit the dog and your rights to a replacement puppy or refund. All ABCA/ISDS/AKC papers must then be transferred and returned to Little Foxx Farms.

If the dog does not work livestock after two weeks, then it shall be replaced within 12 months of the date the dog was returned or a refund will be given. Shipping the replacement puppy is at the buyer's expense.

*There will be no refund or replacement if the puppy is worked on cattle or non dog broke sheep before 12 months of age. (A kick to the head can kill instinct and the puppy.)

Disclaimer:

*If a dog is trained for competitive obedience, agility, or other sports, the dog may not show any interest in working livestock. This is because it's trained from an early age to focus on the handler, treats, ball, Frisbee etc. The dog may not be "keen to work" livestock. If the pup is not purchased specifically for herding, Little Foxx Farms makes no stock working guarantees. Health guarantees will still be valid.

*Prior to one year of age a pup's bones are still growing and developing. Jumping a puppy too high during the growing stage can cause health problems that would not have developed had the puppy's joints not been stressed. If the puppy is jumped over elbow height prior to one year of age, the hip guarantee is null and void.

We always place our puppies in homes we intend to be permanent; however, as the breeder of this Border Collie, we will always accept its return no questions asked. There will be no refund of the original purchase price. Anytime a dog is sent back to Little Foxx Farms for any reason, the ABCA, ISDS and AKC papers must be returned with a signed transfer.

***If for any reason the buyer can't keep this Border Collie, (at any age.) the buyer must contact Sonya Meeks, the seller/breeder. Any potential home that the current owner recommends must be approved and a new contract signed to assure we always know where our dogs are!

The buyer agrees not to surrender his/her dog to a rescue or animal shelter of any type.

The buyer agrees not sell, give away or otherwise dispose of this dog.

This Border Collie purchased from Little Foxx Farms must remain in the same home with the person listed as owner/puppy buyer.

If you ever have problems with your dog at any age, please contact me so that I can advise you how to deal with them.

You agree to have this puppy Spayed/Neutered before 24 months of age.

This is a spay/neuter contract. The puppy purchased under this contract must be spayed or neutered. I do not recommend spay/neutering before 12 months of age unless medically necessary. Dogs need their hormones for growth and development. Unless advised by your vet, it is best to wait until they are fully developed.

Proof of spay or neuter must be sent to Little Foxx Farms. (email/fax/mail) Not doing so will be considered a breach of contract and there will be a fine of up to \$5000.

This written agreement is a binding contract entered into the State of North Carolina in Davie County and any dispute arising shall be resolved within the court system of Davie County North Carolina.

7. Training clicker (whistle for working dogs)
8. Snuggle toy (stuffing free) with the mothers scent.
9. DVD with pictures and videos of your pup growing up.
10. Instructions on how to continue the RAW/Prey model diet our puppies are raised on.
